The Creative Producer ensures overall the use of appropriate program language, and appropriate capture/credits for public performances, workshops, and residencies.

Review proposals for advancing LPDP creative endeavors with venues, partners, and organizations. Advocating equitable practices in dealings of commissions and presentations to emphasize artistic liberation is significant to LPDP development.
